5. The Dooly County Commissioners are seeking candidates for the position of Building Official/Zoning Administrator. Anyone interested in applying should contact County Administrator Stephen C. 8. The current TSPLOST 2013-2022 that is being collected in the sixteen Counties in the River Valley Regional Commission will expire 12/31/2022. The RVRC has begun the process to create a Roundtable to discuss a potential TSPLOST 2023-2032. The first Roundtable meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, September 4th, in Buena Vista. By law, the Roundtable will consist of the County Chief Local Elected Official and one Mayor elected by the Cities in each County.

11. The Springhill Baptist Church requests that the name of Rock Hill Road be changed to Springhill Church Road.

12. In compliance with the Georgia Planning Act of 1989, Dooly County has received a Notice of Development of (Potential) Regional Impact. The City of Cordele has submitted a proposed development which exceeds the DRI threshold for "Truck Stops". Love's Travel Stops and Country Stores has plans for a \$6M development consisting of 10,000 SF store and 10,000 SF tire building on a thirty-acre tract at I-75 Exit 102. Comments on the proposed project will be received by the River Valley Regional Commission through June 28th.
