4. The current term of Judy Burton on the Dooly County DFCS Board expires 06/30/2019.

5. The Dooly County Commissioners are seeking candidates for the position of Building Official/Zoning Administrator. Anyone interested in applying should contact County Administrator Stephen C. Sanders at 229-268-4228 for additional information. A copy of the Employment Application and Job Summary are available at the County Commissioners Office or online at www.doolycountyga.com. This position will be open until filled. Dooly County is an Equal Opportunity Employer.

6. FY2019-2020 Budget. Department Heads were requested to submit their request by July 1st.

7. The current TSPLOST 2013-2022 that is being collected in the sixteen Counties in the River Valley Regional Commission will expire 12/31/2022. The RVRC has begun the process to create a Roundtable to discuss a potential TSPLOST 2023-2032. The first Roundtable meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, September 4th, in Buena Vista. By law, the Roundtable will consist of the County Chief Local Elected Official and one Mayor elected by the Cities in each County.

8. Dooly County will conduct a Scrap Tire Amnesty Event on July 22 - August 8 at the Public Works Department.

9. The Springhill Baptist Church requests that the name of Rock Hill Road be changed to Springhill Church Road.

10. FY2019 LMIG Supplemental Program for Off-System Safety.

11. Middle Flint Behavioral Health Care provides services to meet the needs of individuals with behavioral health, addictive diseases, and development disability concerns in Crisp, Dooly, Macon, Marion, Schley, Sumter, Taylor, and Webster Counties. MFBHC is requesting that the Dooly County Commissioners appoint two individuals to serve on the MFBHS Community Service Board to represent the citizens of Dooly County.

12. Update of ABM Project.

13. Dooly County has received \$58,378.54 from FEMA/GEMA for reimbursement of damages resulting from Hurricane Michael on 10/10/2018:

\$40,023.67	Emergency Protective Services
\$18,354.87	Debris Removal

14. In April 2019, GDOT Officials visited the bridge on Bowen Road at Sandy Mount Creek. The purpose of the visit was to determine if this bridge was eligible for replacement under GDOT's Low Impact Bridge Program (LIBP). GDOT has determined that the crossing on Bowen Road over Sandy Mount Creek was identified with environmentally sensitive areas that require further evaluation prior to determining LIBP eligibility.

15. In April 2019, GDOT Officials visited the bridge on Shiloh Road at Gum Creek Tributary. The purpose of the visit was to determine if this bridge was eligible for replacement under GDOT's Low Impact Bridge Program (LIBP). GDOT has determined that the crossing on Shiloh Road over Gum Creek Tributary has met the required elements and has been programmed for replacement under the LIBP.

16. Northside Senior Center.

17. Mr. Ronnie Cape has submitted his resignation from the Dooly County Planning Commission effective 07/01/2019. Mr. Cape has served on the Planning Commission since its inception in 1997.

18. The Georgia Department of Transportation has reviewed the County's updated Title VI Plan (Nondiscrimination Policy) for the Public Transit Program and has determined that it meets the requirements established by the Federal Transit Administration. The County Commissioners need to formally adopt the new Title VI Plan and submit it to GDOT.

19. Chairman Hudson requests that the August 1st meeting be rescheduled due to a conflict he has.

20. The Office of the Public Defender for the Cordele Judicial Circuit has submitted their funding request for FY2019-2020: \$31,129.09. This is an increase of \$8,980.56 (40%) from FY2018-2019.

21. The next Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners is scheduled for Thursday, July 18, 2019 at 9:00 AM at the Dooly County Commissioners' Office at 113 N. Third Street in Vienna, GA.
