6. Each year, the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) ranks all 159 counties based on certain economic factors for the State's "Job Tax Credit Program": Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3, and Tier 4. For 2022, Dooly County remains in the Tier 1 group.

7. The Dooly County Planning Commission will consider two requests at their next meeting scheduled for 5:30 PM on Monday, February 7th:

Request #1: Thomas L'Esperance and Mary L'Esperance have applied for a Zoning Variance at 3119 Pleasant Valley Road (Tax Parcel 43-14B). They want to build a second residence on the parcel for a caretaker's residence.

Request #2: Shayne Clements, Jennifer Clements, and Zachary Clements have submitted an Application for Re-Zoning at 40 Campers Haven Road (Tax Parcel 12-23). They want the Zoning changed from R-2 to C-1. They want to make a Rental RV Park/Campsite.

8. The 2022 General Primary Election is scheduled for Tuesday, May 24. The Qualifying Period begins at 9:00 AM on Monday, March 7. The Qualifying Period ends at 12:00 Noon on Friday, March 11.

10. The week of February 7-11 is National School Counseling Week.

11. Resource Management Systems Inc. (RMS) is the Third Party Operator for the Transit Program. There has been a change in the Medical Review Officer and Substance Abuse Professional for RMS's Substance Abuse Program. As a result, GDOT requires that the County adopt a revised Substance Abuse Policy for the Transit Program.

13. The next payment on the General Obligation Bonds Series 2015A is due on 03/01/2022 in the amount of \$48,000.00. This is an interest only payment. This will be paid from the SPLOST 2019-2024 Jail checking account.

14. The next payment on the General Obligation Bonds Series 2015B is due on 03/01/2022 in the amount of \$266,191.25. This will be paid from the General Fund checking account.

15. ACCG Retirement Services.

16. The Georgia Department of Transportation has approved Dooly County's 2022 LMIG Application in the amount of \$660,899.93. The Board needs to authorize a new checking account for these funds.

17. The Dooly County Commissioners began serving as the Fiscal Agent for the Dooly County Family Connection in July 2018. The current agreement expires 06/30/2022.

18. The Census Bureau has released information on how to challenge 2020 Census results. The deadline to file a challenge is 06/30/2023.

19. State Law requires that local governments renegotiate the Local Option Sales Tax (LOST) distribution agreements within two years of each decennial census.
