**7. The Board of Commissioners will conduct a Public Hearing on Thursday, March 17, at 9:30 AM to receive public comments on the Planning Commission's recommendations regarding the Rezoning Requests in Agenda Item #6.**

**14. Commissioner Robinson recommends Faye Baker to fill a vacancy on Recreation Board.**

**15. In 2012, voters in three Georgia regions (River Valley, Central Savannah River Area, and Heart of Georgia Altamaha) approved a 10-year one percent sales tax to fund regional and local transportation improvements: 75% of the money generated is used for regional transportation projects; and, 25% of the money generated goes directly to the cities/counties for local transportation projects. Dooly County is one of the sixteen counties in the River Valley Region that have benefited from this transportation sales tax. As of 12/31/2021, Dooly County has received \$7,792,321.08 for local transportation projects. Each of the six municipalities in the County have received funding from the transportation sales tax also. The current transportation sales tax is scheduled to expire December 31, 2022. At the May 24, 2022 General Primary Election, the voters in the River Valley Region will asked if they want to approve this transportation sales tax for another 10-year period.**
