**9. The Annual Legislative Luncheon sponsored by the River Valley Regional Commission is scheduled for Wednesday, May 25, at 10:30 AM at the South Georgia Technical College in Americus.**

**10. Surplus property.**

**11. In 2012, voters in three Georgia regions (River Valley, Central Savannah River Area, and Heart of Georgia Altamaha) approved a 10-year one percent sales tax to fund regional and local transportation improvements: 75% of the money generated is used for regional transportation projects; and, 25% of the money generated goes directly to the cities/counties for local transportation projects. Dooly County is one of the sixteen counties in the River Valley Region that have benefited from this transportation sales tax. As of 12/31/2021, Dooly County has received \$7,792,321.08 for local transportation projects. Each of the six municipalities in the County have received funding from the transportation sales tax also. The current transportation sales tax is**

**scheduled to expire December 31, 2022. At the May 24, 2022 General Primary Election, the voters in the River Valley Region will be asked if they want to approve this transportation sales tax for another 10-year period.**
