The regular meeting of the Dooly County Commissioners was held this date at 9:00 AM at the Dooly County Commissioners' Office in Vienna. CALL TO ORDER

AGENDA APPROVAL

RESIDENTIAL/COMMERCAIL WASTE COLLECTION

Dooly County contracts with Waste Management Inc. for residential/commercial waste collection. The current contract expires 3/14/2024. Previously, Administrator Sanders had inquired if Waste Management Inc. would be willing to extend the current contract for six months to allow the County to go through the RFP process. Today, Steve Edwards with Waste Management Inc. met with the Board and stated that WM would be willing to extend the current contract. Dooly County Solid Waste Manager Lynn Oneal was also present. No action was taken on this matter.

CITY OF LILLY

Administrator Sanders reported that the City of Lilly has requested assistance from the County with putting gravel on the unpaved section of Railroad Street. The Commissioners agreed to provide the manpower and the equipment to put gravel on this section of road if the City is willing to purchase the gravel.

MOBILE HOME DECALS

Tax Commissioner Paula Smith requests that the County Commissioners adopt a Resolution electing not to require mobile home decals. Upon motion by Commissioner Lester and seconded by Commissioner Robinson, the Commissioners voted unanimously to opt out of requiring citizens to purchase mobile decals in Dooly County.

A RESOLUTION OF <u>MOOLY</u> COUNTY, GEORGIA ELECTING NOT TO REQUIRE MOBILE HOME DECALS

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 193 was passed in the 2021-2022 Regular Session of the Georgia General Assembly, and was signed by the Governor and became effective on the 6th day of May, 2021;

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 193 amended O.C.G.A. §48-5-492(a) to allow the governing authority of the county in which the mobile home is located to opt out of the requirement to issue mobile home decals as evidence of a mobile home location permit; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. §48-5-263(11), the appraiser of the County shall, in counties that elect to require decals pursuant to Code Section 48-5-492 inspect mobile homes located in the county to determine if the proper decal is attached to and displayed on the mobile home by the owner as provided by law; notify the residents of those mobile homes to which a decal is not attached of the provisions of Code Sections 48-5-492 and 48-5-493; and furnish to the tax collector or tax commissioner a periodic list of those mobile homes to which a decal is not attached; and

WHEREAS, the governing authority of <u>Dooly</u>, County elects not to require mobile home location decals pursuant to O.C.G.A. §48-5-492(a),

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to and as authorized by O.C.G.A. §48-5-492(a), the Board of Commissioners of <u>Dooly</u> County, resolves and elects not to require mobile home location decals in <u>Dooly</u> County, Georgia, and hereby relieves the Tax Commissioner of <u>Dooly</u> County and the appraiser of <u>Dooly</u> County of any requirements under the law, whether pursuant to O.C.G.A. 48-5-263 and O.C.G.A. §48-5-492 et

seq. or otherwise related to the issuance, inspection, and enforcement of mobile home location decals, and any and all other responsibilities that may have been otherwise required due to the issuance of mobile home location decals.

REPEALER

All previous Resolutions of the Board of Commissioners of **Dooly** County in conflict herewith are hereby superseded and repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption. It shall remain in full force and effect until superseded or repealed.
